SMART PARKING NIGHT SURF COMPETITION POSTPONED

The renowned annual Smart Parking Night Surf event scheduled for this weekend (6th 7th July) will be postponed until October. Due to the poor forecast for waves in Cornwall we have no option but to re-schedule the event.

The jet stream, which is a conveyor belt for swell generating storms in the Atlantic has moved north. Therefore no storms are coming through our swell window. We now have a high pressure sitting on the UK providing this fantastic run of hot weather, but unfortunately not helping with the ocean swell.

Dave Reed Director UKPSA Pro Surf Tour said “It is unfortunate we have had to postpone the event but I believe we have no option and we have an alternate date which fits in well with the tour. To find a true champion we need to, as far as possible, provide the best conditions for the surfers to compete in”. Adding “I would like to thank the sponsors Smart Parking, Korev Larger and Fistral Beach for their understanding with the situation”.

The new dates for the event will be 26th 27th October making it the final event of the 2018 Tour and the deciding competition for who the best surfers in the UK are.

In the meantime, we are looking forward to the upcoming events on the Tour, the UK Schools Championships in 2 weeks time and the Surf Snowdonia Challenge in September.
