Miles Lee-Hargreaves and Emily Williams Champions at the UKs Only Inland Surf Competition

Excited surf fans and curious onlookers made their way to the heart of the Conwy Valley at the weekend to watch the UK's best surfers take part in a unique inland surf competition.

Against a backdrop of the Conwy Valley's forests and mountains, the UK's best surfers came together to battle it out at the Surf Snowdonia Pro Surf Challenge. Thirty four elite UK surf athletes competed in all, travelling from all over the country to the UK's most unlikely break.

After a series of fast-paced knockout rounds, Bude-based surfer Miles Lee-Hargreaves triumphed in the men's competition, with Patrick Langdon-Dark taking second place. First prize in the women's competition went to Emily Williams, from Newport, with last year's champion Emily Currie coming in second.

The Surf Snowdonia Pro Surf Challenge is the only inland stop on the UK Pro Surf Tour, and it's the third time that the event has taken place inland at Surf Snowdonia. Supported by Korev Larger, Fistril Beach, Boardmasters Foundation and Conwy Borough Council, the whole event went out LIVE to over 300,000 social media followers with an estimated total reach of over half a million.

Lizzi Pepper, Events and Promotions Coordinator at Surf Snowdonia said "We're so excited it was broadcast live this year, it's a great chance for everyone to see Surf Snowdonia at it's best and watch some amazing surfing."
